#### **2023 SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT**

Applicants must plan to pursue higher education at a four-year institution leading to a degree in a profession or applied science. Applicants <u>must have an overall grade point average of 3.00 or above.</u>

Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. is a public service organization composed of college educated women, founded in 1913 at Howard University in Washington, D.C. Its membership exceeds 200,000 women in over 900 chapters established throughout the United States and several countries. The activities of the organization focus on Educational Development, Economic Development, International Awareness and Involvement, Political Awareness and Involvement, Physical and Mental Health, along with Social Action and the Arts.

#### ALL APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. An official transcript.
- 2. Two total recommendations from a teacher, counselor or school administrator.
- 3. A student essay sharing what the student is most proud of that has been accomplished during their high school years.
- 4. A personal statement not to exceed 300 words. This is an opportunity for the student to share why they are requesting the scholarship.
- 5. Current head shot photo (professional senior photo size 4x5, 4x6 or 5x7 preferred).

Letters of recommendation should indicate courses taken, achievement in the area of interest, the student's leadership qualities, awards, perseverance, extracurricular and community activities. The scholarship committee will base its selection on evaluation of the transcript, letters of recommendation, student essay and completeness of the application.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN TUESDAY, APRIL 18, 2023. APPLICATIONS POSTED AFTER APRIL 18, 2023 WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.
